ORDINANCE NO. 2017 - 10**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 98 OF THE CODE
OF THE BOROUGH OF PENNINGTON CONCERNING STANDBY FEES FOR
PRIVATE FIRE-PROTECTION SYSTEMS**

WHEREAS, Borough Council seeks to amend certain standby fees for private fire-protection systems set forth in Chapter 98 of the Code of the Borough of Pennington;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Pennington, as follows:

1. **Subsection A of Section 98-42, which establishes standby fees for private fire-protection systems, is hereby amended (with deletions bracketed and new language underlined) as follows:**

98-42. Standby fees.

Quarterly standby fees for private fire-protection systems pursuant to Section 206-2 of this Code are as follows:

A. Quarterly standby fees for private fire-protection systems regardless of the rate or quantity of that service:

Size of Private Lines (inches)	Fee (per connection)
2	[\$125]158
3	[\$300]378
4	[\$450]567
6	[\$925]1,166
8	[\$1,600]2,016

2. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
