

**BOROUGH OF PENNINGTON**  
**Ordinance No. 2010 - 11**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 200, VEHICLES AND PARKING,  
OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF PENNINGTON  
TO PROHIBIT PARKING AT CROSSWALKS**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Pennington wishes to prohibit parking within 50 feet of crosswalks to promote pedestrian safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Engineer has determined that the proposed parking prohibition would further public safety by making pedestrians in crosswalks more visible to motorists approaching crosswalks and by making vehicles more visible to pedestrians entering crosswalks;

**WHEREAS**, State law permits municipalities to enact no-parking restrictions at crosswalks (C. 39:4-138.6);

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 200, Article III of the Code of the Borough of Pennington prohibits the parking of a vehicle at any time on designated streets and parts thereof, as set forth in what is currently § 200-10 of the Code;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Pennington, that Chapter 200, Article III of the Code of the Borough of Pennington is hereby amended by adding to the parking prohibitions now set forth in § 200-10 additional prohibitions against parking at any time within 50 feet of the intersection at the following locations:

<b><u>Name of Street</u></b>	<b><u>Side</u></b>	<b><u>Location</u></b>
S. Main Street	West	from Academy Street north a distance of 50 feet
S. Main Street	East	from E. Curlis Avenue south a distance of 50 feet
S. Main Street	West	from W. Curlis Avenue north a distance of 50 feet
Burd Street	East	from E. Curlis Avenue south a distance of 50 feet
Burd Street	East	from Laning Avenue south a distance of 50 feet
Burd Street	East	from W. Welling Avenue south a distance of 50 feet
E. Welling Avenue	South	from Baldwin Street west a distance of 50 feet

**BET IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Pennington that a copy of this ordinance be provided to the County Engineer of Mercer County.
