

**BOROUGH OF PENNINGTON
ORDINANCE #2011 - 11**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING “AN ORDINANCE
TO PROVIDE FOR AND DETERMINE THE RATE OF COMPENSATION OF
OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF PENNINGTON,
COUNTY OF MERCER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY FOR THE YEAR 2011.”**

WHEREAS, Borough Council by Resolution has appointed Wayne Blauth as Tax Collector;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Pennington, as follows:

1. Section Ia of Borough of Pennington Ordinance No. 2011-10 (“AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR AND DETERMINE THE RATE OF COMPENSATION OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF PENNINGTON, COUNTY OF MERCER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY FOR THE YEAR 2009”) is hereby amended to provide for the following salary for the positions of Tax Collector, Utility Collector and Deputy Tax Collector:

Deputy Tax Collector - to April 30, 2011	\$16,564.80
Tax Collector – Effective May 1, 2011	\$17,214.40
Utility Collector	\$17,214.40

2. Section V of the aforesaid Ordinance is further amended by the addition of the following sentence:

“This Ordinance shall remain in effect until superceded.”

3. This amendatory ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as provided by law.
