# BIODEGRADABLE LAWN BAGS, LEAF AND BRUSH COLLECTION

## BIODEGRADABLE LAWN BAGS - NEW!

Since January 2015, the Borough of Pennington has been providing all residents with biodegradable lawn bags. These bags are for disposal of leaves that are not collected during seasonal curbside leaf collection and are for organic yard waste including sticks, twigs and hedge trimmings. Yard waste placed at the curb in biodegradable bags will be collected by the Department of Public Works throughout the year.

- Leaves are still to be raked to the curb for vacuum collection - the bags are NOT a replacement for the curbside collection of leaves (see below for details on vacuum leaf collection)
- Weight of bags/containers is NOT to exceed 40 lbs
- After you receive your initial bundle containing five (5) lawn bags, they will be available for delivery through the Department of Public Works at (609) 737-9440 or can be picked up at Borough Hall
- There will be NO COLLECTION of any yard waste in any form in PLASTIC bags
- Grass clippings are NOT permitted in the biodegradable lawn bags
- Landscapers are prohibited from participating in the Lawn Bag Collection Program

## LEAF COLLECTION

Leaf collection begins in October and runs through January 1<sup>st</sup>.

- Place leaves at the curb or the edge of the roadway in long rows
- Do NOT place sticks, branches, stones, weeds or mulched grass into the leaf pile
- After January 1<sup>st</sup>, all leaves should be placed in containers or biodegradable lawn bags for pickup

## BRUSH COLLECTION

Brush collection is ongoing throughout the year (weather permitting).

- Stack brush on your side of the sidewalk with the butt end of the branch toward the road
- Leave branches long - 8' to 12' is good (the machine does not do well with short branches)
- Do not mix logs or vines with the brush

- Cardboard Food Boxes & Powdered Detergent Boxes
- Telephone Books & Soft Cover (paperback) Books
- Hard Cover Books (hard cover must be removed)
- Glass Food & Beverage Jars/Bottles (all colors)
- Aluminum & Metal Beverage Containers
- Juice Boxes & Juice/Beverage Cartons
- Milk Jugs & Plastic Beverage Bottles
- Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs
- Detergent & Shampoo Containers
- Plastics with #1 or #2 Symbols
